

Small Group Questions – The Week of October 9, 2016

Scripture Reading: 1 Peter 1.2-9

Questions for Discussion

1. Why do our problems and pain sometimes feel “more present” to us than God and His promises? Are there problems or pain that feel that way for you now?
2. Read 1 Peter 1:3. How is our “living hope” connected to Jesus Christ?
3. Why is it important to have hope in something objective and stable, versus subjective and changing?
4. Peter says our inheritance is, “imperishable, undefiled, and unfading (1 Peter 1:4)?” How is this different than an earthly inheritance that we might receive?
5. What did Rev. Davis mean when he said we should “stand tall and push our feet through the floor” into the foundation of the Triune God?
6. How does this passage provide a sense of stability and purpose when we are “grieved by various trials (1 Peter 1:7)?”
