

Sermon Discussion Questions for Small Groups

Week of March 25th

Sermon Titled: "The Humility of God"

Open in Prayer. Read Matthew 21:1-11.

As you begin, ask the group: How would you summarize the main points of the sermon? What stood out to you about the sermon? What questions did you have? What challenged you?

Note for the discussion and application questions: choose a couple of the questions below to discuss and go deeper with the sermon together.

Application & Discussion Questions

1. Who is this (v.10)? That is the critical question of this passage. How would you answer this question if someone asked you who is Jesus?
2. Jesus' Kingship is all over this passage.
 1. What comes to mind when you think of a king?
 2. Where do you see Jesus' Kingship reflected in this text?
3. Jesus' humility is also all over this passage.
 1. How would you describe a humble person? What do they do? What are they like?
 2. How do you see Jesus' humility reflected in this text?
4. Read Zechariah 9:9 and compare it with how Matthew uses it in 21:5.
 1. What does he leave out?
 2. Interestingly, "salvation" in the Hebrew in Zech. 9:9 connotes a physical rescue compared to a spiritual rescue that we often think of in the New Testament. What do you think Matthew is emphasizing about Jesus' character as their coming King?
5. Read Psalm 118. What in this psalm stands out as a reminder and anchor of your identity in Christ?
6. What has stirred your affections for the Lord this Lenten season and /or Holy Week?

Prayer Focus: Pray that God would draw you closer to Him this Holy Week, and that you would have fresh eyes to behold the gospel of Jesus Christ and the power of the cross. Pray for all those who will visit this Easter Sunday who do not yet trust in Jesus; may God grant them salvation!
