Small Group Questions — The Week of December 6, 2020

Sermon Overview: After describing the reality of God's people walking in darkness, Isaiah prophesies about the coming Messiah and says, "His name shall be called Mighty God." The revelation breaks into this darkness with a promise and prophecy. There is real hope for God's people. The fulfillment of this promise and prophecy will be a person—a person who is Mighty God. We, too, live in dark times. How are we to live in light of this Mighty God? This Sunday, we will see this Mighty God on display as He does what only He can do to deliver His people. His power and His might are far greater than the darkness you are encountering, but the darkness is greater than you know. Come ready to see and hear and be reminded of who you are and what you have in Him—the Mighty God.

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 9:2, 6-7; Mark 5:1-20

1. Why do you think Isaiah gave the name Mighty God to Jesus?
2. How would you describe His might?
3. How is His might reflected in the deliverance of the demoniac?
4. What encouragement do you find in this story for your own story today?
5. Why wouldn't Jesus let the man follow Him?
