Small Group Questions — The Week of January 10, 2021

Sermon Overview: Between the bookends of praise, Psalm 106 remembers the people of God's rebellion and the relentless grace of God. The knowledge of sin can only lead to praise when seen in the light of God's steadfast love. As pastor Jack Miller says, "Cheer up! You're a worse sinner than you ever dared imagine, and you're more loved than you ever dared hope."

Scripture Reading: Psalm 106

1. Psalm 106 opens and concludes with "praise the Lord." What reasons does the psalm give for celebration?
2. In what ways have the people of God sinned as recounted in Psalm 106? How do these sins manifest themselves today in your own life and in the life of the world?
3. What is God's response to the sins of His people?
4. How does this psalm teach us to pray?
5. What is the right response to God's grace and steadfast love?
