Small Group Questions — The Week of January 31, 2021

Sermon Overview: The feeding of over 5000 is the only miracle mentioned in all four Gospels. Each account refers to the place as a desolate wilderness with no provisions. Bread is suddenly available for everyone. Does this sound familiar? What is Jesus doing, and why did no one believe Him?

Scripture Reading: Mark 6: 30-44, 51-52; John 6:25-27, 30-36

1. What had the disciples been doing before Jesus fed the crowd? (See Mark 6:7,30)
2. How does the term “desolate” mentioned twice impact the story?
3. Why did Jesus ask the disciples to feed the crowd?
4. What is the point of having the disciples gather up what was left over?
5. What should the disciples have learned and why not? (See verse 52)
