Seeing & Hearing the Gospel of Jesus Christ

Small Group Questions — The Week of March 21, 2021

Sermon Overview: How do you know that something is true? Our Western world is built around the idea that seeing is believing. If we cannot observe it with our eyes, we assume that it cannot be true. But what if the greatest Truth the world has ever known is something we cannot see? And what if that Truth changes the way we see everything? Join us this Sunday as we continue our sermon series through the Gospel of Mark and find out why believing is seeing.

Scripture Reading: Mark 8:22-26

1. What is the relationship between faith and seeing in the Bible? How does the sense of sight help us understand the nature of faith?
2. What does it mean to be spiritually blind?
3. It took a group of people to lead the blind man to Jesus. Who are the people that God has used to lead you to Jesus?
4. Why did Jesus only partially heal the blind man at first?
5. How does the blind man's blurry vision teach us about the way that we sometimes see Jesus? How does your vision of Jesus compare to the Jesus we see in the Bible?
6. The Gospel of Mark tells us that Jesus "restored" sight to the blind man. What does this tell us about the man's blindness? How is the mission of Jesus about restoration?
7. How are you like the blind man? Has Jesus fully opened your eyes to see the Gospel? What do you see?
