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## Small Group Questions — The Week of April 4, 2021

**Sermon Overview:** As we celebrate the life, death, resurrection, and reign of our Lord and Savior on Easter, let us look again into the tomb and see all that is there and all that isn't. The women who walk to the tomb with spices for Jesus' dead body leave trembling and astonished because He's alive. As we travel to the tomb, led by the Holy Spirit, we, too, should expect to tremble and to be seized with astonishment. Our Savior is alive! He's ALIVE! Come, and come expectantly, to lift high the name of Jesus and to our astonishment, live transformed by the reality of His living presence.

**Scripture Reading:** Mark 16:1-8

2. How would you describe their condition?
3. What happens as they arrive at the tomb?
4. What are they told to do?
5. What do they do?
6. What does it mean, and why is it significant that "trembling and astonishment had seized them"?
7. How might this instruct the way we should think of the Resurrection?
