The following questions help us dialog with the sermon, music, and liturgy in this morning's worship service. Together, these elements provide space for reflection and prayer during personal devotions, group studies, and family worship.

1. What strikes you about the way Daniel was set up?
2. What enables followers of Christ to endure such opposition and follow Him all the way to death?
3. What stood out to you about the life of William Tyndall?
4. Why is Daniel 6.10 so critical to our understanding of our own preparedness?
5. In what aspects of our life (spiritual disciplines, time, money, gifts, work, etc.) can what we "had done previously" reveal our readiness to lay down our life for Christ? How?
6. Where do you see disconnects in your own life? Why are they present? What will change the way you think? Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you.
