1. How would you say the world defines hope? What is different about the hope Paul is praying for them to know?
2. What does it mean to be called to a hope?
3. What does Paul mean by, "the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints"?
4. How does this inheritance encourage you today?
5. How would you describe "the immeasurable power" Paul prays for the saints to know?
6. How should we expect to understand and experience this power?
7. Where in your life are you trusting in a lesser hope, a lesser inheritance, and a lesser power?
8. How is this hope, inheritance, and power seen in the cross and the resurrection?
9. How might Paul's prayer for the Ephesian saints begin to influence your prayers?
